## Online news research and newspaper article clipping services

Researchers have the unique opportunity to discover the intricacy of South Africa's past and present as reflected in its newspapers. Sabinet's news resource, South African News, is a living archive of invaluable insights from 1977 to present day.

Meeting the diverse needs of public and government libraries, universities, various private and government institutions, and researchers, our users are offered online access to the news research and news clipping service of SA Media (News Clippings) and Sabinet Newswire.



**An astounding number of titles** – with access to a database of prominent South African newspapers' articles and newswires, users can browse numerous titles, some of which are no longer in publication.



**Discover the extent of South African news** – with Sabinet Discover, users have a single search interface which allows them to search the breadth of this incredible news collection.



**A comprehensive collection** – with two newswire archives, more than 100 archive newspapers as well as over 30 current newspapers with new articles added daily, the collection continues to grow.



**Standalone or together** – newswire archives as well as newspaper publisher collections can be subscribed to separately or as a part of a larger group.

## SA Media (News Clippings)

- Covers mainstream publications in South Africa from 1977 to present day.
- Has over 5,4 million archived news articles.
- Adds approximately 2500 news articles weekly, 3-6 weeks after the publication date.
- Contains full-text PDFs of actual articles where every word is searchable.
- SA Media (News Clippings) covers selected articles on particular subjects and with the snippet feature on Sabinet Discover, the section of the newspaper in which the article appeared in is indicated.
- Single and bundle-serving specificity – users can purchase single articles or purchase a download package.
- Special download packages are available for schools and individual researchers.

## Or subscribe to individual collections:

### Independent Newspapers

- A one-stop shop providing a holistic research destination of the Independent Newspapers' collection.
- Among others, home to The Star, The Mercury, Pretoria News, Sunday Tribune, and Cape Times.
- Dates back to 1977 and regularly updated.

### The Citizen

- The Citizen was founded in 1976 and since 1977, SA Media (News Clippings) has been collecting news clippings from this publication.

### Arena Holdings

- Collecting various prestigious titles, Arena Holdings is home to newspapers such as Business Day, Financial Mail, Sunday Times, and The Times.
- These articles date back to 1977 and are regularly updated.
- A one-stop shop for Arena Holdings titles.

### Sabinet News Clippings Archive

- A collection of 100 titles, many of which are no longer being published.
- Contains a number of historical titles such as The Friend, Die Afrikaner, and African Armed Forces.
- Dates back to 1977 until each respective end date.
- Historical titles available online for your convenience.

### Sabinet Newswire

- A newswire archive dating from 1999 until September 2022 consisting of the South African Press Association (SAPA) and African News Agency's (ANA) wires.

### South African Press Association (SAPA)

- Although SAPA closed in March 2015, Sabinet continues to make the unique archive collection of SAPA newswire articles available.
- This archive is accessible through a Sabinet Discover subscription or articles can be purchased singly.
- Updated from their newswire format, articles can now be downloaded as easy-to-view PDFs.
- Available to users as a standalone collection.

### African News Agency (ANA)

- ANA newswires are available in an archive collection from November 2015 to September 2022.
- Provides South African and African news covering politics, economics, business and markets, sports, and general news.
- Has easy search functionality.
- A comprehensive database of over 200 000 articles, each downloadable as a PDF.
- Available to users as a standalone collection.
